The Nusantara Fund declined -7.89% in June, bringing YTD performance to -10.57%, compared to the JCl's +1.18% gain in USD terms. The underperformance was largely driven by our exposure to the tech sector, with the IDX Tech Index down 3% as sentiment remained weak despite strong structural tailwinds. Broader market conditions were steady, with the JCl trading in a narrow 6,900–7,200 range, as investors weighed inflation trends, rate policy, and signs of consumer strain.

While the first half of 2025 proved challenging, we enter 2H25 with cautious optimism. July's IPO pipeline is robust, with nine companies going public and investor interest rebounding. We are fortunate to have secured allocations in several of the most anticipated listings, and early momentum suggests a meaningful reversal of recent losses. With improving sentiment, renewed risk appetite, and strong deal flow, we believe the worst is behind us and remain focused on navigating the recovery with discipline and conviction.
